ENHANCING LOCAL AUTHORITIES' CAPACITY FOR DEVELOPMENT (EU-LA MINING PROGRAMME) LAUNCH EVENT

PRETORIA - The Centre for Local Capacity Building (CLCB), in collaboration with VNG (Association of Netherlands Municipalities) and Musina Local Municipality will officially be launching the EU-LA Mining Programme on the 24th of April 2018. This programme is funded by the European Union and will be implemented over a duration of three years. The objective of the Programme is to support the capacity development of five (5) selected mining Local Authorities (LAs) in South Africa, to effectively engage mining companies within their jurisdiction to the legislated mandate of mine-community economic development and inclusive growth. It is designed to enhance the capacity of mining Local Authorities through tailored programme activities.

The Ambassador of European Union Delegation to South Africa, Dr. Marcus Cornaro will attend and provide the Keynote Address of the event. The event will also be attended by several high ranking local government officials who will engage in a Grand Debate on **'Co-creation and plausible solutions for effective engagement between local government and the mining sector in present day South Africa'**
