SALGA Gauteng to convene Provincial Conference on 8 - 9 February 2022

Following the local government elections in 2021, the South African Local Government Association (SALGA) in the Gauteng province will host its elective provincial conference on the 8th -9th February 2022, at Glenburn Lodge, Muldersdrift.

To be held under the theme “Intergovernmental and Institutional Cooperative Agility to Deliver Tangible and Evidence-based Services” the conference will see the Premier of Gauteng, David Makhura, deliver the keynote address as well as panel discussions on critical issues pertaining to local government.

Guests and delegates at the provincial conference include relevant MECs, Mayors, Speakers, Municipal Managers, and Chief Financial Officers of all eleven municipalities in the province, civil society, business and academia.

The provincial conference is held every five years, within 90 days of the local government elections as provided for by the constitution of SALGA. The convening of this conference is highly significant as it serves as a platform for local government to set the tone and agenda next 5-year local government democratic term and the 2022- 2027 strategic agenda of SALGA.

The conference will further:

- Elect the members of the Provincial Executive Committee.
- Nominate two Members to the National Executive Committee.
- Establish and review provincial oversight bodies as required by law; and



- Approve the provincial programme of action and budget in respect of the ensuing five years.
