Please find the attached declaration and resolutions and kindly note the responsibilities for municipalities on the resolutions.


PROGRESS MADE THUS FAR

- Key role-players to the implementation of the resolution are, the Department of Health, SALGA, Treasury and COGTA. Hitherto, an implementation matrix reflecting the areas of responsibility for each of the key role-players has been developed by SALGA and the Department of Health to track implementation of the mentioned resolutions.
- SALGA working with other role-players such as South African Institute for Environmental Health (SAIEH) and National and Provincial Department of Health are currently developing a manual for the induction of new portfolio councillors on Municipal Health Services.
- The Environmental Health Indaba report will be presented to the reconstituted SALGA governance structures.
