SALGA Northern Cape to convene the Provincial Members Assembly (PMA), 1-2 December 2022 in Port Nolloth

The Provincial Executive Committee (PEC) of the South African Local Government Association (SALGA) in Northern Cape, led by its Chairperson, Councillor Michael Segede will convene its first annual PMA of the current term of local government (2021-2026) at the Drop-in-Centre in Richtersveld Municipality, Port Nolloth on 1-2 December 2022.

Held under the theme, “Investing in a modern, growing and successful Province – a local government contribution”, the PMA is a constitutional meeting of all member municipalities in the province that is convened between provincial conference. It brings together under one roof senior decision makers in municipalities made up of Mayors, Speakers, Municipal Managers and Chief Financial Officers.

Northern Cape Premier, Honorable Dr. Zamani Saul will deliver the keynote address and set the tone for the two-days deliberations. The NEC Deployee for SALGA in Northern Cape Councillor Mapaseka Nkoane and the MEC for Cooperative Governance, Human Settlement and Traditional Affairs (CoGHSTA) Mr. Bentley Vass will be participating in the programme.

Amongst other things that will be discussed on the agenda of the PMA will be the impact of coalition governments on service delivery and municipal governance as well as ethical leadership as a catalyst for effective oversight and accountability.

The PMA will further serve as platform for robust engagements among sector specialist in the form of three different commissions which some of the topics will be on governance and administration, service delivery and local economic development.



The key and ultimate objective of this legislated sitting is to make a declaration when it comes to an end which will be a commitment by the PEC to forge ahead with plans for the Northern Cape as encapsulated in the overall Annual Performance Plan (APP) and Annual Operational Plan for the financial year and reflect to what has been achieved.
