Media Briefing to introduce the newly elected SALGA KZN leadership

In line with its Constitution, the South African Local Government Association convened its Provincial conference to amongst others review the progress made since the 2016 conference, define a programme of action, framework for the SALGA Strategic plan and elect the SALGA KZN Provincial Executive Committee.

The conference focused on electing the new SALGA KZN leadership that will steer the organisation and the sector for the next 5 years. The Provincial Executive Committee is the highest decision making structure in the Province and all municipalities were offered an equal chance to nominate and elect the leadership of their choice.

Cllr Thami Ntuli, Mayor of King Cetshwayo District Municipality was elected unopposed as the SALGA Chairperson in KwaZulu-Natal. The conference saw the appointment of 3 deputy chairpersons, 6 ordinary members, representatives to the National Executive Committee, National Council of Provinces, Provincial Legislature and the Chairperson of the SALGA Provincial Women's Commission.
