Ekhulumela iKomidi eliPhezulu leSouth African Local Government Association (SALGA) KwaZulu-Natal, uKhansela Thamsanqa Ntuli uphendule ngezikhukhula kanye nezimvula ezinamandla KwaZulu-Natal. USihlalo uphatheke kabi ngesimo esenzeka esifundazweni. “Siyazi ukuthi isimo sisaqhubeka, ngakho-ke kungenzeka singazi ukuthi ungakanani umonakalo. Nokho, sekucacile ukuthi ukulahlekelwa imiphfumulo, nokulahlekelwa izindlela zokuziphilisa kwenzekile. Sidlulisa amazwi enduduzo emindenini yabashone ngenxa yale nhlekelele,” kusho uNtuli.

UNtuli uqhubeke wathi, “njengo SALGA; simema imboni ezimele, eholwa yizinhlaka zamabhezini ezihlelekile Kwazulu-Natal, ukuthi zibambisane nomasipala ohlelweni lokulungisa isimo. Siphinde futhi sicele bonke omasipala abakhahlanyezwe yizikhukhula ukuthi benze amahholo omphakathi atholakale njengezindawo zokukhosela zesikhashana futhi baxhumanise nozakwethu bomphakathi ukuze basize ngemizamo yokulungisa isimo. Izimeya zikhuthazwa ukuba zimemezele ngokushesha isimo senhlekelele ezigcemeni ezithintekile ukuze zihlanganise usizo lwezenhlalakahle kanye nezinsiza ezitholakalayo.”

The SALGA KZN Chairperson Calls On Municipalities To Provide Temporary Shelter And Should Declare A State Of Disaster.

Speaking on behalf of the Executive Committee of the South African Local Government Association (SALGA) in KZN, Cllr Thamsanqa Ntuli reacted to the floods and heavy rainfall experienced in KwaZulu-Natal. The Chairperson is saddened by the situation unfolding in the province: “We are mindful that the situation is still unfolding, so we may not know the true extent of the damage. However, it is already clear that loss of life and livelihood is a reality. We express our condolences to the families of those who have passed on due to this disaster,” Ntuli said.

Ntuli said, “as SALGA; we invite the private sector, led by organized business structures in Kwazulu-Natal, to partner with municipalities in the recovery process. We further call on all municipalities impacted by floods to make community halls available as temporary shelters and coordinate social partners to assist with the recovery efforts. Mayors are encouraged to speedily declare a state of disaster in impacted wards to mobilize social relief and resources made available.”
